



NCAA Eligibility/NAIA Eligibility

Students planning to earn an NCAA Division I or Division II scholarship or an NAIA sports scholarship at the collegiate level should complete the following steps:

1. Make sure you are completing NCAA approved courses at Boylan, if able. View the [Boylan Student Handbook, pages 41-42](#) and/or meet with your counselor.
2. Do well in your courses, especially core courses, so that you meet the grade point average requirements for NCAA/NAIA.
3. NCAA – complete registration at www.eligibilitycenter.org (\$75.00 fee)
NAIA – complete registration at www.playnaia.org (\$75.00 fee)
4. Sign up for an account at www.parchment.com and send your transcript to NCAA/NAIA once you have completed junior year (June). The fee to send a transcript to NCAA/NAIA is \$5.55.
5. Send your ACT score(s) to NCAA/NAIA. Request to send your scores for free through your ACT account before you test. Or, if you have already taken the ACT, visit www.actstudent.org and choose “send your scores”. The fee to send an ACT score is \$12.00.
