

HISTORY AND PROCESS

In 2007, alumni, former and present faculty, administration and benefactors met with His Excellency the Bishop of Rockford, Thomas G. Doran to discuss the future of Boylan Catholic High School. This group recognized that while the school enjoys many strengths and opportunities, it also faces needs and challenges.

To better understand Boylan's position in the competitive marketplace and to identify solutions, the school retained the management consulting firm of Gonser Gerber Tinker Stuhr, LLP .

The school then initiated a strategic planning process to develop institutional priorities. Advancement Director Lynn McConville was designated as the liaison to GGTS and to coordinate the overall committee process.

Five Task Forces researched best practices and made recommendations in these areas critical to the school's success:

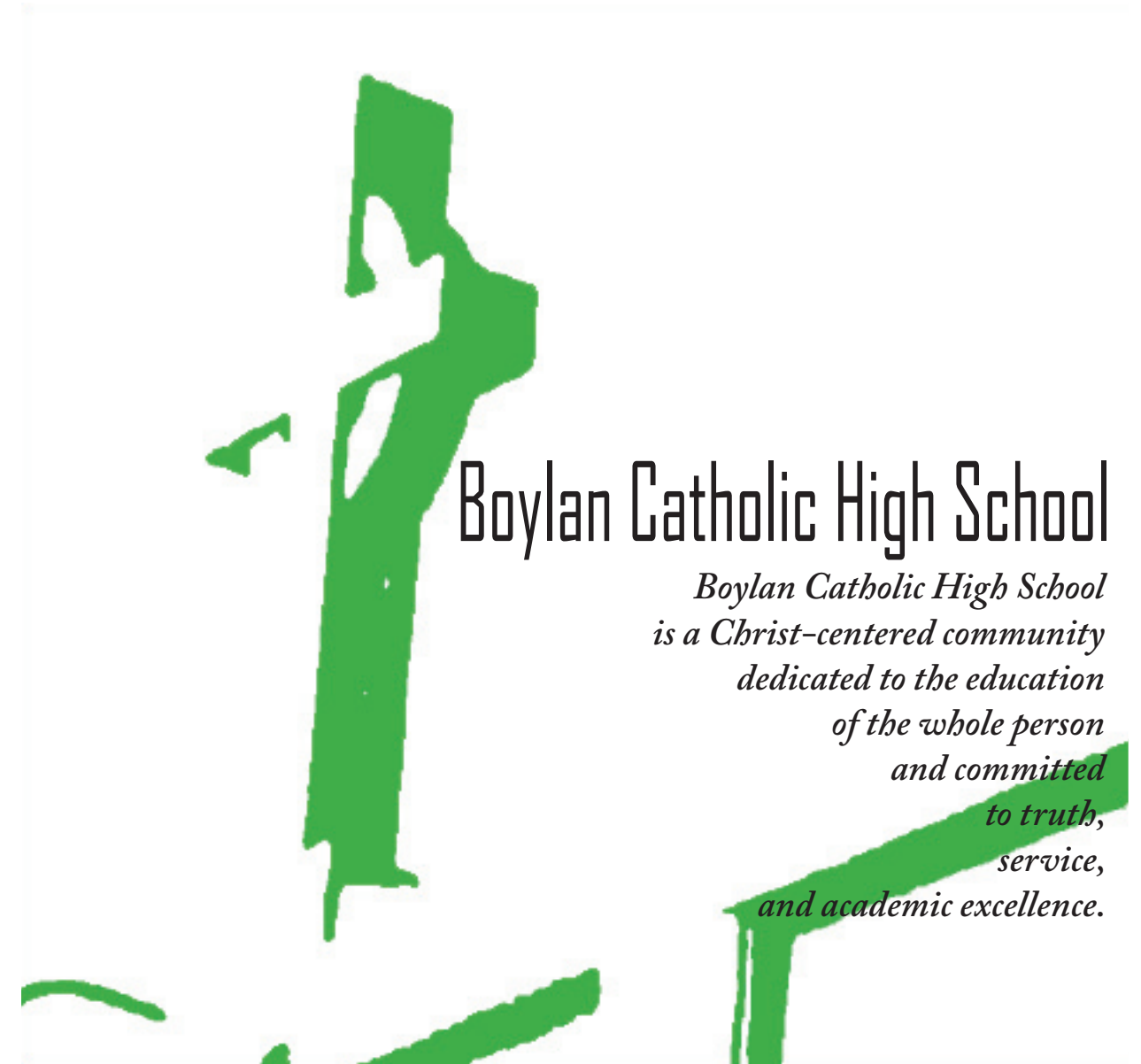
